The must carry provisions of the 1992 Cable Act must be analyzed for compliance with the First Amendment under a heightened standard of review, rather than under the relaxed standard of First Amendment scrutiny traditionally applied to broadcast regulation. The justifications for extending rational basis review to broadcast regulation -- the scarcity of broadcast frequencies and the potential for signal interference if two broadcasters attempt to transmit over the same frequency -- are inapplicable in the context of cable regulation because cable television does not suffer from the inherent physical limitations that characterize the broadcast medium. Given the rapid advances in fiber optics and digital compression technology, there will soon be no practical limit on the number of speakers that may use the cable medium. Nor is there any danger of interference between two cable speakers attempting to use the same channel. Further, the mere assertion of dysfunction in the cable television market is not, without more, sufficient to shield cable regulation from the First Amendment standards applicable to nonbroadcast media.
